NARRATIVE <div style="margin-left: 40px;"> <p>STATEMENT OF KEITH GOOD:</p> <p>Keith Good essentially told me the following: I asked Keith about his lifeguard's training and he explained they follow the standard set forth by the Red Cross. He teaches from the Red Cross lifeguard manual and gave me a copy of the book from his classroom. There are also videos, hands on training, practical tests and written tests as part of the training.</p> <p>I asked Keith if when he came back into the pool area and realized there was a rescue going on if he felt the need to intervene and help out. Keith explained that he was not "on the clock" and knew his insurance would not cover him as a teacher and not being part of that group. After seeing Hailey and Michal performing the rescue, he believed they had it under control since they're both professionals and knew what they needed to do. The only reason Keith got involved and called 911 was because the booster club was supposed to be in charge but didn't know what to do. He went on to explain that in lifeguarding, the first rescuer is the person in charge and Keith didn't want to step in and second guess Hailey and mess up the rescue chain of command.</p> <p>INVESTIGATION (CONT'D):</p> <p>Later during the day on 6/6/16, Detective Martin interviewed two additional witnesses to the incident. He spoke with Rylie Spivey and Brian Bonus at the police station, both of whom were reported to have pulled Alex up from the bottom of the pool. See Detective Martin's report for details on their interviews.</p> <p>On 6/7/16, I reviewed the details of my investigation so far and what I had learned during the interviews. I determined that I needed to re-interview Keith Good and some of the lifeguards in order to get some further clarification on the incident.</p> <p>Detective Martin and I went to Vista Murrieta High School and spoke first with Keith Good inside the School Resource Officer's office and our conversation was recorded.
